



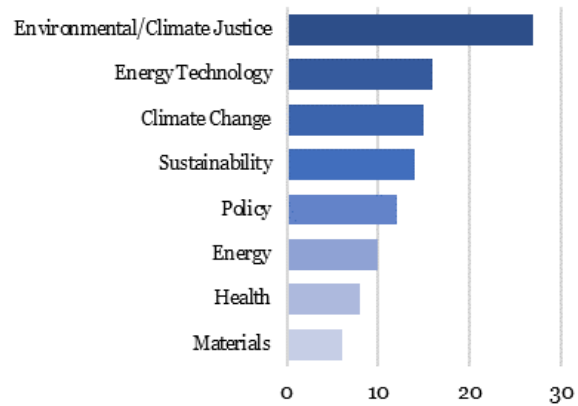
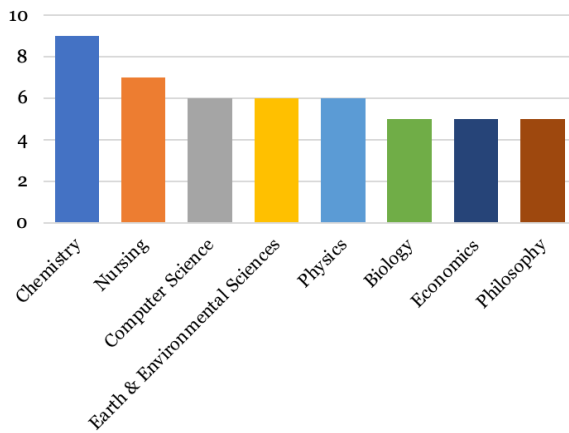

Post-survey results from faculty convenings, which were held in Spring 2021, provided data on the interests of Boston College faculty in key Institute areas of focus. These results are summarized below.

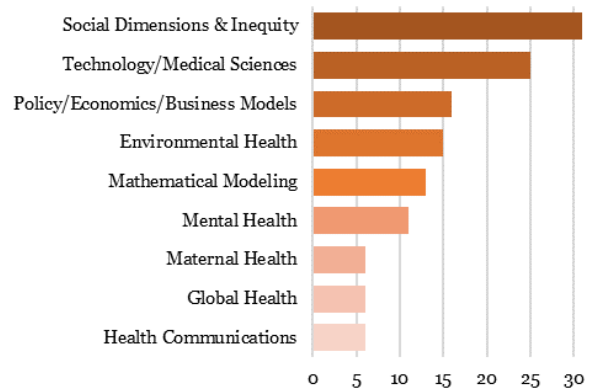
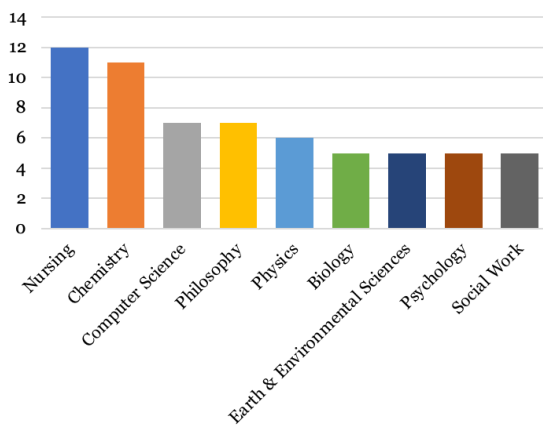

High-Interest Sub-Areas ¹



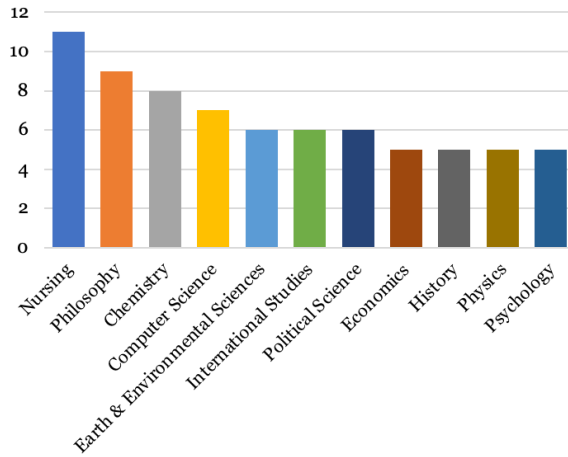

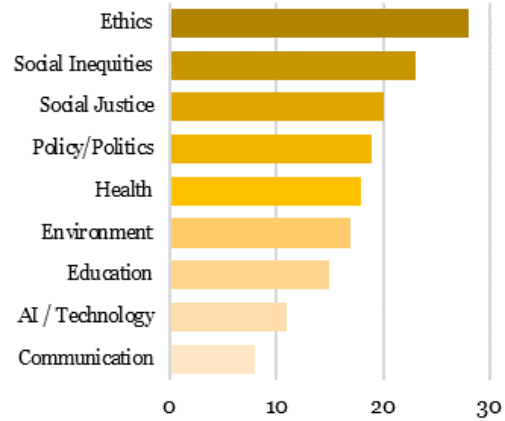

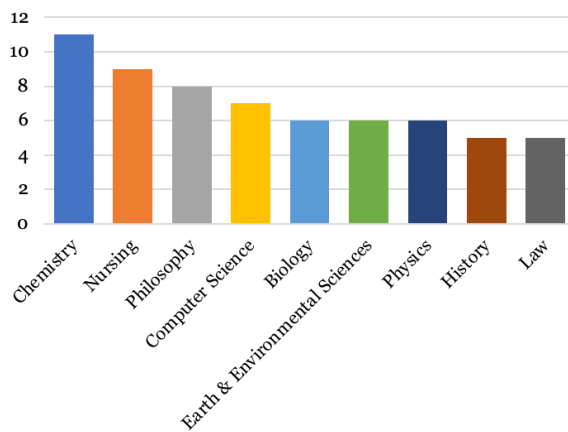


High-Interest Sub-Areas³

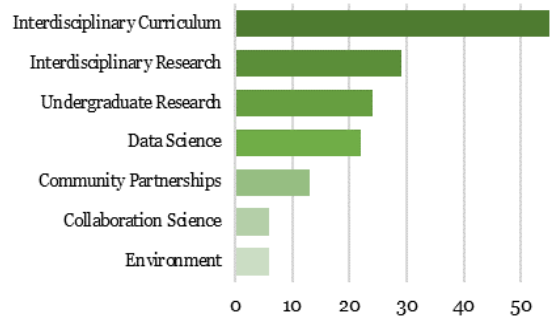
