STATEMENT OF SCHOLARLY INTERESTS


My program of research is focused on the biobehavioral factors underpinning symptom perception among patients with heart failure. I have secured extramural funding beginning with an American Heart Association Clinically Applied Research grant to support my doctoral work. As part of my dissertation, I developed and psychometrically tested an instrument to assess heart failure symptom burden. It is used by several investigators and has been translated into Spanish, Italian, Turkish, Portuguese, Chinese, Japanese, Kannada, French, and German. My doctoral dissertation on delay in care-seeking was presented at the 2003 American Heart Association Scientific Sessions when I was a finalist in the Martha N. Hill New Investigator Competition. My dissertation was subsequently published in *Research in Nursing & Health* and has been cited 159 times. A proposal to the Hartford Foundation following my PhD resulted in a two-year post doctorate at the University of Pennsylvania (Claire M. Fagin Post-Doctoral Fellow). During this time, I conducted a mixed methods study on delay in care-seeking among older adults with heart failure. My post-doctoral work was presented at the European Society of Cardiology meeting in Birmingham England as I was a finalist in their New Investigator Competition. The paper also was published in *Nursing Research* and it has been cited 138 times. Following my post-doctoral work, I secured an American Heart Association National Scientist Development Grant to conduct a clinical trial to improve symptom recognition among patients with heart failure. My scholarly work has resulted in 44 peer reviewed publications in high impact journals, 6 book chapters, and over 100 presentations given locally, regionally, nationally, and internationally. Finally, my work has been recognized with several awards. I received the highest honor in nursing when I was recognized as a fellow by the American Academy of Nursing in 2014. I also received the 2015 Mathy Mezey Award for excellence in aging research, education and practice by the Cardiovascular Nursing Council of the American Heart Association. I hold 2 fellowships in the American Heart Association (CVSN council [2008] and QCOR council [2009]) and became a fellow of the Heart Failure Society of America in 2016. Currently, two IRB approved pilot studies to support an NIH R01 grant application are in progress after a one-year delay in enrollment due to Covid.

I have held several positions in nearly 3 decades in academia. I served as Associate Dean for Research in the School of Nursing from July 2010 until September 2013. In this role, my goal was to position the Stony Brook School of Nursing as a foundation for research and scholarship within the school. I used a multifaceted approach that provided multiple opportunities for collaboration on research, grants, and publications. A primary goal was to promote and facilitate faculty and student research and grant writing at all levels. As the School of Nursing is part of an academic medical center, this included integration of Stony Brook University Medical Center's research agenda. Therefore, I actively collaborated with the medical center's Associate Director of Nursing Quality and Research. I also was a member of the GCRC General Advisory Committee and supported the CTSA application. Developing an Office of Nursing Research with opportunities and resources for research supports

the strategic plans of both the school and Stony Brook University. My scientific foundations, built on my education and research experience, supported building the culture of research and scholarship both within and outside of the School of Nursing. Currently, I am an Associate Professor with tenure at Boston College. I teach research-related courses across programs. Finally, I am currently the interim director of the PhD program at Boston College. My objectives are to formalize the mentoring and tracking of student progression, revise the curriculum to strengthen methodological and statistical acumen and to support faculty in their mentoring roles of PhD students. To support these aims, a Canvas site will be established with resources for students and faculty, faculty meetings will be conducted each semester and students will develop formal goals for scholarly productivity with written annual reports. These strategies will afford highlighting student achievements to demonstrate the quality education gained at Boston College.

My philosophy of teaching is based on achieving student understanding by promoting students' active involvement in the learning process. Using both significant and transformative learning theories, I create assignments starting with the outcome desired followed by development of the sequential steps leading to the outcome. Scholarly discourse is an essential part of this process. Students are encouraged to question prior assumptions and actively search for answers to their questions. Students are asked to turn information 'over in their hands' to examine various aspects of issues and concepts and to seek and accept critique. I believe being accessible, responsive and providing timely feedback is important as students move through the curriculum. My goal is to mentor students to support development of skills necessary for life-long learning, high-level evidence-based nursing practice and research.
