Professor of Sociology

Zine Magubane is a Professor of Sociology at Boston College; she holds a courtesy appointment in the department of African and African Diaspora studies. Her areas of specialization include social theory, sociology of post-coloniality, race and ethnicity, globalization, race and popular culture, gender and sexuality, and the sociology of African societies.

Professor Magubane is the author of Bringing the Empire Home: Race, Gender and Class in Britain and Colonial South Africa (University of Chicago Press, 2004). Her work has appeared in Signs, Gender and Society, and Critical Sociology. Her newest book, Another Sociology is Possible: Slavery, Colonialism and the (Re) Making of the Classical Canon, is forthcoming from the University of Chicago Press.

Professor Magubane completed her MA and PhD in Sociology at Harvard University.

#### Days 1 & 2 | In Transit

Depart for Cape Town, South Africa. You may depart on Day 2 or have a layover at an international airport along the way.

#### Day 3 | Cape Town, South Africa

Upon arrival in Cape Town, transfer 3 to the Belmond Mount Nelson Hotel.

Later, join us for a Welcome Reception.

#### Day 4 | Cape Town

After, discover the many highlights of South Africa's Mother City. Drive through the Company's Garden district, see the Castle of Good Hope and stroll along a bustling harbor.

#### Day 6 | Hoedspruit | Kapama Private Game Reserve

Following breakfast, fly to Hoedspruit. Upon arrival, transfer to the Kapama River Lodge. **Safari:** Get the lay of the African bushveld during your first game drive in Kapama Private

Game Reserve. Meet your ranger and tracker, who will accompany you on each game drive. Begin your quest to spy the marvelous Big Five.

#### Day 7 | Kapama Private Game Reserve

Each morning on safari starts with a wake-up call from your ranger. Meet on the deck for coffee before climbing into your vehicle.

**Safari:** It may seem quiet as the sun starts its journey across the sky, but there is plenty of animal activity. Many animals are just waking up and preparing to search for breakfast! Others are winding down after a night on the prowl and looking for a place to sleep during the day.

**Free Time:** Spend the rest of the morning at your leisure. Visit the spa or relax with a book.


#### **Enrichment:** The Animals of Kapama.

**Safari:** Get a different perspective as you see diurnal animals settling down for the evening and nocturnal animals beginning theirs.

As the sun sets, celebrate your day with a round of sundowners, drinks enjoyed at sunset.





#### Day 8 | Kapama Private Game Reserve

**Safari:** Each game drive is a unique experience forged by the time of day, the weather and the locale. Your tracker and ranger are experts in finding animals. They know the thickets where giraffes nibble at the treetops, the open veld where zebra graze and much more.

Free Time: Enjoy time at leisure.

**Safari:** Today, you may scout popular watering holes where four-legged and feathered residents gather.

#### Day 9 | Hoedspruit | Johannesburg

Transfer to Hoedspruit and fly to Johannesburg.

# Day 10 | Pretoria | Embark Rovos Rail | Zimbabwe


### Life on Safari


On this luxury safari, discover the landscapes and ecosystems of three outstanding wildlife parks.
